

1. Readmission will be offered on a space available basis to qualified students who apply by the deadline.
2. **Academic Placement** – The academic placement (class year) of individuals readmitted to Norwich will be determined by the amount of degree credits earned and posted to the Norwich academic record as of the approval date of readmissions.
3. **Degree Requirements** – Students who are readmitted to the University shall be responsible for meeting the degree requirements and regulations in effect for their particular class and curriculum at the time of readmission.
4. **Separation** – Students who have been readmitted to the University after having been separated for an unsatisfactory academic or disciplinary record will not again be readmitted if they are separated a second time for academic or disciplinary cause.
5. **Notification of Action on the Application for Readmission** – Individuals will be notified of their acceptance for readmission, or rejection, as soon as their application is processed. This normally requires approximately three weeks.

It is essential to note that if you have attended a college or university since your last attendance at Norwich University, a decision on this application will not be taken until an official transcript reflection that work is received by the Office of the Registrar from the school at which the work was taken. You must contact the school to request that the official transcript be sent to the Norwich Registrar's Office. Be sure to enter the date by which the Norwich Registrar may expect to receive your transcript.

6. Upper-class civilian students may live off campus without permission. Civilian freshmen are permitted to live off campus for only of the following three reasons:
 1. They are at least 5 years older than their academic peers
 2. They live at home with their legal guardian within commuting distance of campus
 3. They are married
