If the natural parents have divorced and the custodial parent has remarried, “parents” are the custodial parent and the stepparent.

You do not need to list the student or parent name and age information for a second time within the family member listing section.

Provide income information about the student, the student’s spouse if married, and the student’s parents if the student is not married. For assets, do not include the value of the family’s primary home of residence, or retirement-specific savings accounts.
