Be sure to visit the following locations virtually or in-person

- 1. Financial Aid Office: Student Loan Exit Counseling is required for all students who have borrowed Federal Education Loans during their Norwich enrollment. Please follow these instructions:
 - Click here to log in using your FSA ID (if you have issues with your FSA ID, call 1-800-433-3243)
 - Go to My Checklists
 - Select I'm in School and then select Exit Counseling
 - · Notification of completion will be sent to the Office of Financial Aid
- 2. Registrar's Office: The Registrar's Office will perform final degree audits once all grades are due, link to Academic Calendar. Full details regarding processing deadlines are housed on the Registrar's SharePoint site. A student no longer able to access SharePoint may email registrar@norwich.edu.

Helpful tips:

- Curriculum Verification The student will receive an email sent to the student's Norwich and permanent/home email asking to review their degree and major(s), etc. with instructions for how to correct. Timelines vary based on the student's completion date.
- Participation in Commencement Exercises attendance is indicated on the student application. To change the response, email registrar@norwich.edu (residential programs) or registrargrad@norwich.edu (online programs).
- Accommodation/Accessibility The line-up location to the venue requires stairs; each student will also access a stage with stairs. If the accommodations survey was not answered, complete the survey via BannerWeb, Student Profile Page, Personal Information (Answer a Survey-Grad App Extra Questions). Inactive students must email registrar@norwich.edu (residential programs) or registrargrad@norwich.edu(online programs).
- Graduation Applications Applications are due October 1st for spring/ summer degree completion and the prior year March 1st for fall/winter degree completion. Late applications may be submitted via BannerWeb (active students) or at this link for inactive students. Note, ticketed seating for guests may not be available to late applicants. Review the ticketing information page.
- Degree Audit A student is encouraged to continuously review the DegreeWorks degree audit to ensure that all requirements are met or are in progress, to include the credit requirements at the top of each section. The advisor is the point of contact for questions. A registrar staff member will review the final audit and send an email notification when requirements are not on track requesting an update to the degree completion timeline. See also the graduation application policy.
- Military College of Vermont (MCV) The requirements for the MCV are vetted by the Commandant's office. Please direct requirements and completion deadlines to commandant@norwich.edu.
- Final Official Transcripts approximately two weeks before the degree conferral, a student may request a final official transcript at this link. Ensure that the order is marked hold for degree.
- Credential Please refer questions regarding the credential (diploma/ certificate) at this link. In addition to information regarding the electronic credential.
- Transient Course A student taking a course through another institution
 must complete a transient course request. Information may be found at this
 link. A credential cannot be conferred until the final official transcript is sent
 directly to Norwich University. Complete instructions are at this link.
- 3. Order Regalia and Graduation Items: If you are on the list to graduate this year and plan to participate in Commencement on April 27th, 2024, please order your regalia no later than February 25th, 2024 if you are a campus-based graduate or by March 21st if you are an online/CGCS graduate.
