CAPTAIN MATTHEW D. FELTMANN

Captain Matthew D. Feltmann is the Assistant Professor of Aerospace Studies for Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps Detachment 867 at Norwich University, Northfield, Vermont. In this capacity, he recruits, trains, evaluates and motivates highly qualified men and women as prospective officers and instructs the freshman-level course on the Foundations of the United States Air Force.

Captain Feltmann was commissioned through Reserve Officer Training Corps, graduating from Texas A&M University. He earned his pilot rating through Undergraduate Remotely Piloted Aircraft Training at Randolph Air Force Base, Texas. Captain Feltmann has flown the MQ-1B and then the MQ-9A as an instructor and evaluator pilot with more than 500 combat hours, more than 1,300 combat support hours and more than 3,500 combined aircraft primary flight hours. He has deployed four times conducting launch and recovery operations for three Major Commands. Captain Feltmann has served in diverse mission sets and operations to include, Operation ENDURING FREEDOM, FREEDOM SENTINEL, JUNIPER SHIELD and INHERENT RESOLVE. Prior to his current assignment, he was the Bravo Flight Commander of the 65th Special Operations Squadron, Hurlburt Field, Florida.
