

Captain Bradley S. Lilly is the Recruiting Officer and Assistant Professor of Aerospace Studies for Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps (AFROTC) Detachment 867 at Norwich University, Northfield, VT. In this capacity, he recruits, trains, evaluates, and motivates highly-qualified men and women as prospective officers and instructs the freshman-level course on the Foundations of the United States Air Force.

Capt Lilly led a deployment of 46 Airmen to Andersen AFB, Guam to provide munitions support for the Continuous Bomber Presence (CBP) missions in the Pacific.
